



ProjectRx Survey (2008)

The following results were obtained during November of 2008. Surveys were provided in the Vendor Area of the PMI New Jersey International Project Management Day event and at the registration table during the PMI New Jersey Chapter Meeting.

- ✓ **69%** reported that their organization performs formal assessments or audits (**59%**), or would like to (**10%**).
- ✓ Time and the lack of a formalized process were the most common obstacles to performing assessments.
- ✓ **11%** reported that their organization performs formal assessments or audits without an established framework. **10%** reported that their organization has an established assessment framework but does not perform formal assessments or audits.
- ✓ **77%** thought that PMBOK® does not adequately address project assessments.
- ✓ **52%** would like to see a Specific Interest Group or SIG established for Program & Project Assessments.
- ✓ **65%** would like to see a Practice Standard developed for Program & Project Assessments.
- ✓ **39%** would volunteer to participate in a New Jersey based Local Interest Group or LIG for Program & Project Assessments.

- Time, management support, money
- Too small a company
- Reluctance to formalize PM
